



Facility Use Policy for Guests

The Catawba Riverkeeper Foundation is a 501c3 non-profit organization based in McAdenville, NC and responsible for preserving, protecting, and restoring the Catawba-Wateree River Basin which includes more than 8,900 miles of waterways in 26 counties in North and South Carolina.

Catawba Riverkeeper operates for use by its members and their guests a Private Club in McAdenville, NC at 102 Main Street, Suite 100 called The River Room. This facility is open to all full members of Catawba Riverkeeper as well as some limited members as outlined in the Full and Limited Memberships policy.

Both full and limited memberships entitle the member to bring up to 6 guests per visit with them during normal operating hours of the club. Operating hours will be posted on the facility website: riverroom.catawbariverkeeper.org Guests will be subject to all rules and regulations of the private club while on premise and failure to comply with these rules may forfeit their guest privileges as well as the member privileges of the member hosting them.

Guests may also attend events hosted by a member that are deemed private events where the member rents the use of the facility exclusively for their private event. In these cases, more than 6 guests will be allowed.
